This is true with the Rockland Breakwater
Lighthouse. From a distance, which is
how most see the lighthouse, it looks in
fair condition. But, in fact, it is not.



The Rockland Breakwater Lighthouse, the only one of its type in the nation, was in deplorable condition when this project began. Ceilings were falling in, stair steps were missing, wood was rotted, plaster was hanging from walls and ceilings, pipes were broken, doors were displaced and debris was scattered throughout the station. This monument, a worldwide symbol of the City of Rockland, must be restored to be saved for future generations to enjoy.

This will be a difficult lighthouse to renovate.
It is estimated that it will cost \$250,000 to restore the Rockland Breakwater Lighthouse.

The Friends of the Rockland Breakwater Lighthouse has no paid employees. All funds raised for the restoration of the Rockland Breakwater Lighthouse go directly to the restoration project.

There will be no taxpayer money used to restore the lighthouse.
All funds for restoration must come from private donations.
